Meeting Minutes

The Public Works Committee for the Town of Osceola met for a regular bi-monthly meeting Thursday, October 12, 2023, at 7:00 am at the Osceola Town Hall (garage), Dresser, Wisconsin.

Call Meeting to Order: Chair Lindh called the meeting to order at 7:04 am.

Verification of Meeting Posting: It was confirmed that the notice was posted at the Town Hall, Dresser Post Office, the First National Community Bank, the Town Web site, and the Town Facebook stie.

Approval of previous meeting minutes:

Discussion about current / future road projects

- Discussion on possible future purchase of road broom. \$16,000 to \$20,000 (placed on hold)
- Continue ditch mowing larger areas next to fields.
- Spray patching is completed, and we covered 10.5 miles of roads.
- Road stripping has not begun yet. Todd will call to find out when we are on their schedule.
- Looked at rust holes on one ton truck dump box. The truck is 2015 Todd will look at cost of new steel dump box is about \$8,500
- Talked about updates on fixing gutters. New Town sign has been installed.
- Waiting on more information on oil costs for working with other Towns to perform chip sealing next year.
- Update on new double axel dump truck. Todd is working on final numbers for box and accessories with Universal Trucks.
 - \$185,000 for basic truck 2025 (\$5,000 deposit on 11-11-2023) Should be ready in May of 2024.
 - \$160,000 for box, blades, and sander (hope to pay for this early 2025)
- Discussed inspection and service of current dump trucks for winter season.
 - International Truck is currently being work on by Cameron Diesel Repair
 - \$4,000 in needed repair cost
- Consider upgrading ditch mower. May consider purchase of a different ditch mower at end of year.
- Tony to look at possible road grants for 93rd Ave. No update at this time.
- Discussion on purchasing and hauling sand / salt starting next week.
- Discussion on continue to shoulder road in Oct / Nov
- In the process of trimming trees along and over roadways.
- Look at get new front tire chains for the International truck.
- Start pulling docks out of the lake Oct 23rd
- Todd asked to purchase (2) signs "Fresh Oil" and (1) sign "Loose Rock"

Discussion about current Public Works budget:

- Went over current budget and future purchases.
- Went over 5-year road plan.
- The maximum part time hours is 1,200 before retirement money is required per calendar year.
- 2024 road projects:
 - Repave 3 miles
 - Chip seal 8 miles
 - Crack seal 3 miles
 - Spray patch 12 miles
 - Replace 4 culverts.
 - Stripping
- Need to replace rear tires on Mack truck in 2024 \$5,000.
- Look at replacing Sand Lake dock. The dock is about 50ft long.
