The Public Works Committee for the Town of Osceola met for a regular monthly meeting Thursday, April 25, 2023, at 7:00 am at the Osceola Town Hall (garage), Dresser, Wisconsin.

**Call Meeting to Order:** Chair Lindh called the meeting to order at 7:05 am.

**Discussion about current / future road projects**

- Waiting for more information on oil costs for working with other Towns to perform chip sealing next year. Out for bid, May 6<sup>th</sup> bid opening.
- Sand / salt shed is 25% full.
- Todd is looking into road training classes for himself.
- Culvert on 200<sup>th</sup> Street
  - The road was closed on March 6<sup>th</sup> due to road shoulder washing out and the bottom of culvert has rusted out.
  - Polk County and DNR have been contacted to help with permits since there is a stream flowing through the culvert.
  - Official paperwork has started with DNR.
  - DNR is to have a review middle of next week for permit.
  - (2) 60" culverts are in our possession.
  - New signs for road closure have been installed.
  - Waiting for permits from DNR to start project.
- Discussion on patching on repairing potholes during spring road thaw.
  - Have patched 3 ton so far.
  - Locally of out cold mix.
- Discussed ARIP grant and possibly using Daniel Fedderly, with DJ Fedderly Management Consultant LLC, to help with preparing grant.
  - 60<sup>th</sup> Ave from 240<sup>th</sup> street to CTY road M
  - 218<sup>th</sup> street from 60<sup>th</sup> Ave to CTY road M
- Delmore Consultant's will be used for culvert inspection.
- Seasonal weight restrictions on Town roads were removed April 25, 2024. Except for 200<sup>th</sup> (CTY F to 90<sup>th</sup> ave).
- Summer 2024 road projects:
  - 200<sup>th</sup> Street- GSB-88: May
  - 70<sup>th</sup> Ave- pulverizing / repaving:
    - Gravel lift on May 1 &2
    - Pulverizing mid May
    - Paving June
  - 110<sup>th</sup> Street- pulverizing / repaving:
    - Pulverizing mid May
    - Paving June
  - 240<sup>th</sup> Street- crake seal: partial done.
  - 248<sup>th</sup> Street- crake seal: completed.
  - Chip sealing:
    - Mid / late summer

- Spray patching: oil is same price as last years.
  - Start around May 15<sup>th</sup>.

**Discussion about current Public Works budget:**

- One ton truck dump:
  - Look at fixing holes in dump box.
  - Discussion of possible future upgrade of one-ton truck. No update
- Discussed conditions of current dump trucks for winter season.
  - The International truck is back from shop working ok.
- Need to replace rear tires on Mack truck in fall of 2024 \$5,000.
- Update on new double axel dump truck.
  - \$185,000 for basic truck 2025 (\$5,000 deposit on 11-11-2023) Should be built June 18th.
  - \$170,755 for box, blades, and sander completion January 2025 from Universal
- Went over current budget and future purchases.
- Went over 5-year road plan budget.
- New dock for Sand Lake installed.
- Garbage cans and porta-pottys have been installed at the landing and Town parks.
- Discussion of possible future office build-out for shop. No update.
- Discussion of possible hot water fix of kitchen sink. No update
- Discussion of possible future rental or purchase of smaller payloador. No update
